


COMES NOW, Petitioner National Football League (NFL), and moves this Court pursuant to N.C.G.S. §132-1.4, for a Consent Protective Order so that any information, copies of documents, photographs or other materials, provided by the Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office ("MCSO") to counsel for the Petitioner, such as an inventory log of weapons and photographs of weapons seized by MCSO pursuant to an Order entered on or about 5-15-14 by Judge Becky Tin to Gregory. M. Hardy ("Hardy") to immediately turn over to law enforcement any and all weapons and firearms currently in his possession or to which he would otherwise have access, which Order was added as a condition to Hardy's then current bond; shall be used solely for the internal purposes of the NFL on a need to know basis only and shall not be used or disclosed by counsel for Petitioner or by Petitioner or Petitioner's employees or agents for any other purpose than the internal use of the NFL with regard to any disciplinary actions pertaining to Gregory M. Hardy. Such documents shall not be distributed publically by Petitioner or by any agents, employees or representatives of Petitioner. Undersigned counsel for Petitioner also agrees, on behalf of himself and his client, the Petitioner, that no materials produced by the MCSO pursuant to this Order shall be disseminated to any other party or agents of any other party, without being subject to the provisions of this Order. Counsel for the MCSO consents to the entry of this Order, provided all terms and conditions in this Order are complied with by all affected parties. Petitioner further agrees that anyone employed by or any agents of Petitioner who review the investigative materials provided by MCSO will be on a need to know basis only, each of whom shall personally acquiesce to the

confidentiality provisions of this Protective Order and shall not disclose the contents of the materials provided to the Petitioner pursuant to this Order. These individuals shall so signify their acquiescence by signing for receipt of a copy of this Motion and Order. A copy of each such acquiescence shall promptly be provided to MCSO by counsel for the Petitioner.

Petitioner agrees to reimburse the MCSO for document reproduction fees, at the rate of ten (10) cents a page, upon notification from MCSO that the documents have been copied and MCSO requests such reimbursement. Such reproduction fee is applicable when an excess of twenty (20) pages of MCSO documentation have been copied.







COMES NOW, Petitioner National Football League ("NFL") and moves this Court pursuant to N.C.G.S. §132-1.4 for a Consent Protective Order so that any information, documents, photographs or other materials, provided by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department ("CMPD") related to confidential criminal investigative materials identified by Complaint# 20140513041800 and related to the arrest and prosecution of Gregory Hardy, that any such materials provided shall be used solely for the internal purposes of the National Football League and shall not be used or disclosed by counsel for Petitioner or by Petitioner or Petitioners employees or agents, for any other purpose than the internal use of the NFL and any disciplinary actions, and shall not be distributed publically by Petitioner or by agents, employees or representatives of Petitioner. Undersigned counsel also agrees that no materials produced by the CMPD pursuant to this Order shall be disseminated to any other party or agents of any other party, without being subject to the provisions of this Order and counsel for the CMPD consents to the entry of such an Order. Petitioner further agrees that anyone employed by or any agents of Petitioner, who review the investigative materials provided by CMPD, is subject to the confidentiality provisions of this Protective Order and shall not disclose the contents of the materials related to the arrest and prosecution of Gregory Hardy, and shall signify that acquiescence by signing for receipt of this Motion and Order, to be provided to CMPD.

Petitioner agrees to reimburse the CMPD for document reproduction fees, at the rate of ten (10) cents a page, upon notification that the investigatory documents have been copied. Such reproduction fee is applicable when an excess of twenty (20) pages of CMPD investigatory documents have been copied.


